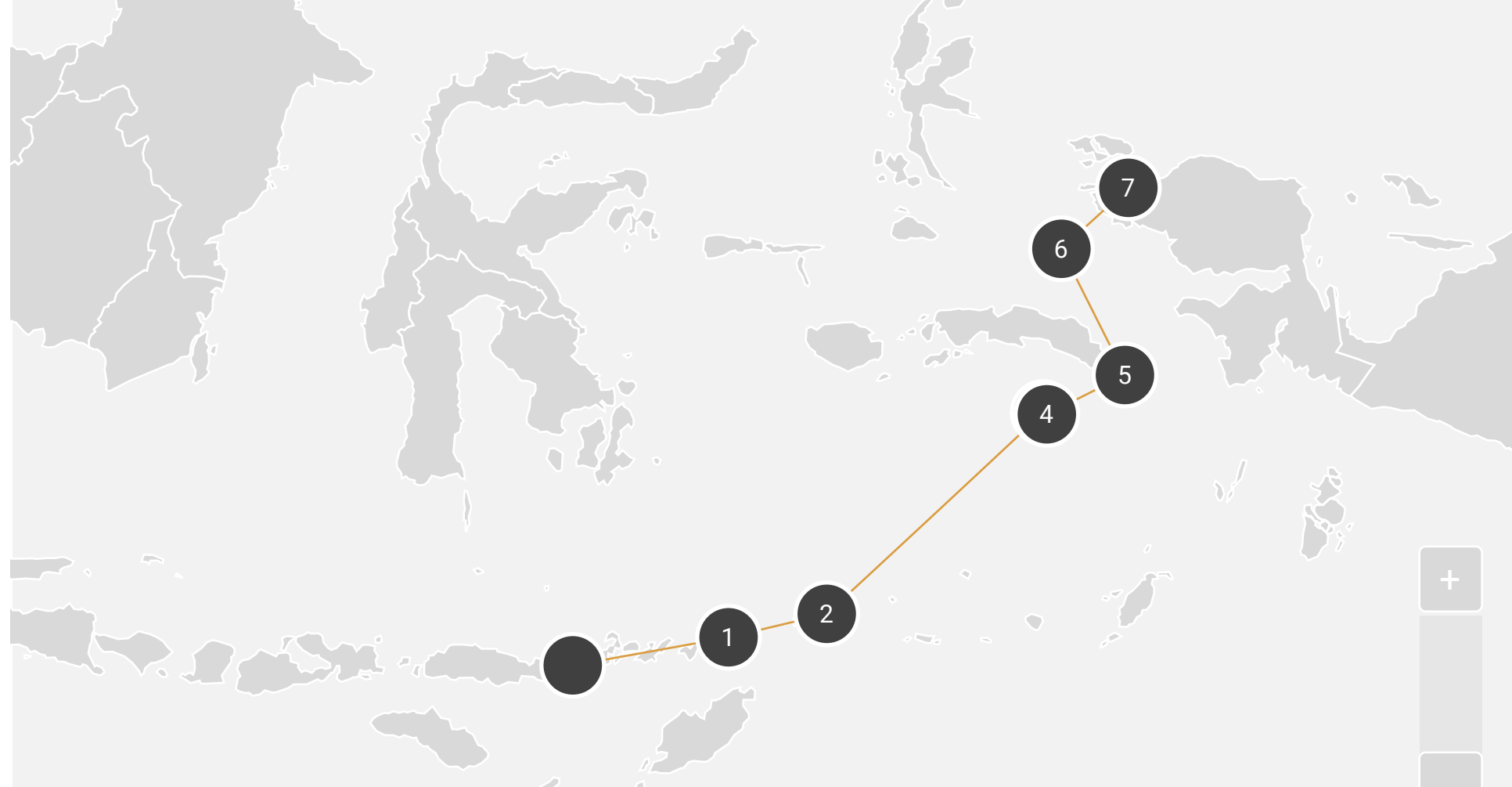




EAST INDONESIA ADVENTURE

West Papua is undoubtedly the best dive site in Indonesia and one of the diving eldorados in the world.

The tour leads from Sorong to the famous dive sites near Kri and manta point near Mansoar.

In the second part of the tour we go to the coral and macro paradise at the island of Misool. Places like Gorgonian passage, Fiabacet and many other dive sites guarantee colourful and memorable dives.

Another highlight are the historic Banda Islands. Originally the birth place of the lucrative nutmeg trade, the islands endured vicious fighting in the past. Today only few remember the bloody wars of the past. The real richness and beauty of these islands is now known to be the life in the ocean. Guests can expect to experience a diverse and extraordinary under water landscape among the Banda Islands. Dive spots like Batu Kapal will impress even the well travelled divers. Unique to this trip is also a dive in the lava stream that erupted in 1988 and is now one of the fastest growing places for table corals. There are also smaller marine creatures in large numbers to discover at the Banda Islands and dive sites with many mandarin fish.

Diving among the snake island Gunung Api will leave a lasting memory. This small volcanic island is surrounded by steep, rocky cliffs reaching over 4000m in depth. Even though there is less diversity of marine life available compared to Raja Ampat, it none the less presents a unique diving environment. Nowhere else can so many and diverse types of sea snakes, native to this region, be seen. Gunung Api is also the nesting place of large colonies of ocean birds. During calm seas it is possible to explore the island on foot.

After diving in Alor we will arrive in the bay of Maumere.



PROGRAM

Day 1

The Amira crew picks up our guests from the airport or hotel. After a welcome drink, our guests check in to their cabins. Afterwards there will be breakfast or lunch, depending on the time of arrival. When all guests are on board and have settled in, a detailed boat and safety briefing will be given by the cruise director. In the afternoon, the general diving briefing explains the process and organization of our diving operations. Usually there are no dives offered on the first day.

Day 2-10

We offer 3-4 dives daily, including a dusk or night dive if possible. During crossings we do a maximum of 2 to 3 dives per day.

Day 11

Last diving day with a maximum of 2 dives and cruise to disembarkation harbor.

Day 12

Check out and transfer to airport or hotel accompanied by our crew.
