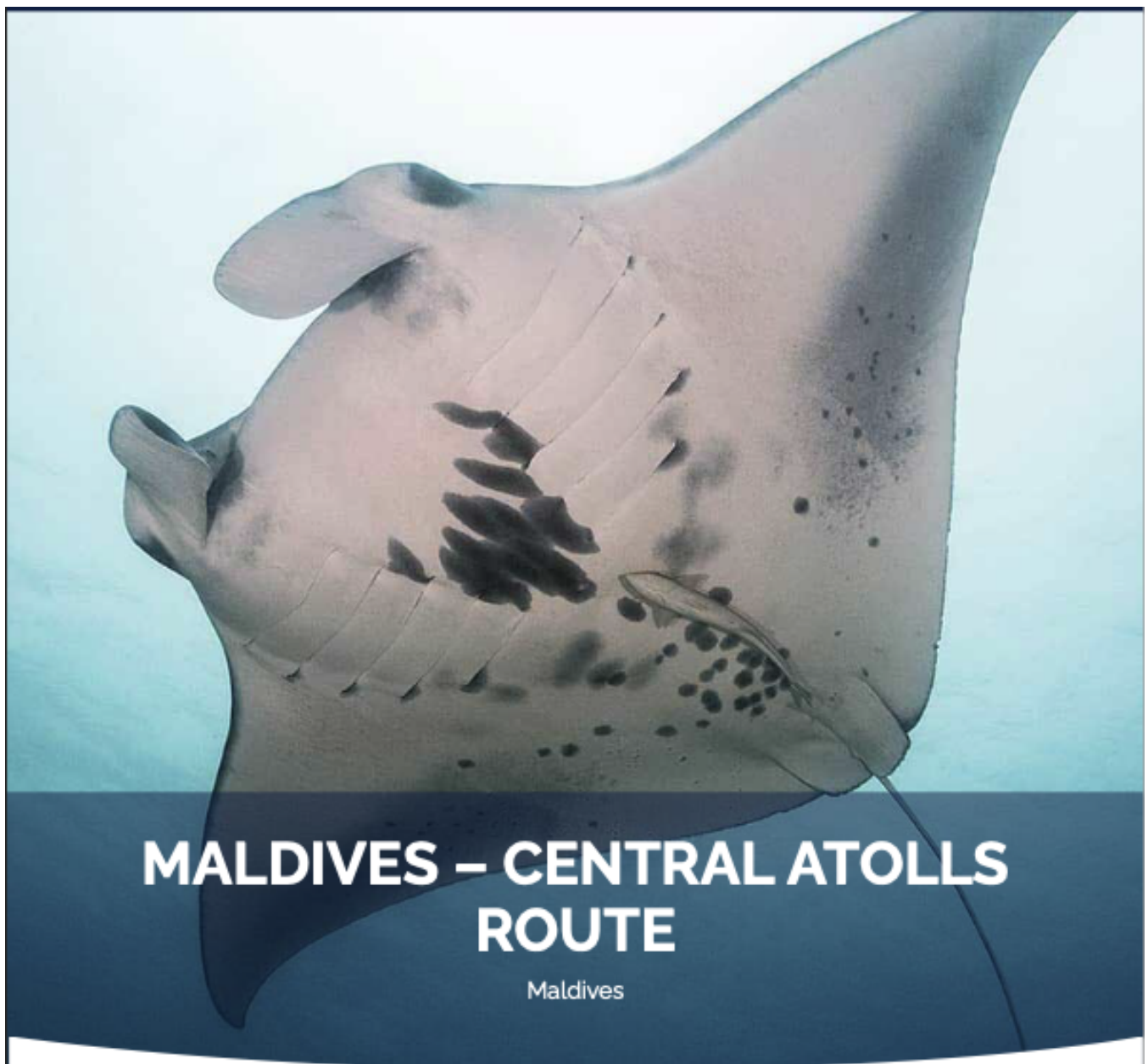




This is the best-known route in the Maldives, and at the same time it is the one that offers the best and most varied dives. We go on this route 11 months a year (except June) with weekly departures. Thanks to that, we know every detail, atoll, passage, thila and where and when it is convenient to approach every dive zone.

It is a 7-night route including 6-dive days on board, with embarking and disembarkation at Male Airport (18 dives).

The itinerary goes by North Male, South Male, Felidhoo and Ari Atolls.

The aim is to find pelagic, grey sharks, white-tip sharks, black-tip sharks, and in some occasions hammerheads and dolphins, eagle rays, schools of colourful fishes, morays, tuna fish, gilt-head breams, groupers and turtles. Drifting dives take place in water passages and canals, and thilas (submerged coral seamounts), with cleaning stations where big mantas gather to be cleaned, and the search for the whale shark (and if we're lucky, snorkelling and even diving with the biggest fish). We will also dive a full-of-life wreck.

Desert islands and typical fishermen villages are also visited to discover a bit more of the country, and if the weather allows we'll even have a BBQ lunch on an island.

Although if you're looking to relax, you can enjoy the solarium and jacuzzi on board, along with kayaks and paddle SUP.

All that makes for an excellent, unforgettable and amazing dive travel experience for divers and non-divers alike.

Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1 (Saturday): Arrival to Male - Embark

Arrival at Male airport. One of our staff members will be waiting for you at Male Airport. You will then get onto our auxiliary boat Dhoni for the transfer to Maldives Blue Force One or 3 for check-in (boarding from 11:00am), briefing of the liveaboard, diving and plan itinerary. Dinner onboard.

Day 2 to 7 (Sunday to Friday): Central Atolls Route

The route will go through North Male, South Male Atolls, Felidhoo and Ari Atolls. Daily dive programme for certified divers, including day dives, night dives and the possibility of snorkelling and diving with whale sharks (total 18 dives per week). For non-divers, we offer different activities such as snorkelling, kayak and paddle SUP. If the weather and logistics allow, we will have a BBQ on a desert island and will visit some populated islands. On Friday afternoon we will anchor next to Male, so we will have the option to make a guided visit to Male.

Day 8 (Saturday): Male Airport

Disembark at Male Airport at 7:00am. If the return flight leaves in the afternoon, there is a day hotel option available near the airport, with free time to optionally visit Male until the time of the return flight.

Included

- Transfers airport - boat - airport.
- Stay in a double cabin sharing on Maldives Blue Force One or 3, on a full board basis.
- Water, tea and coffee.
- 18 dives including tanks, weights, guides, and diving boat (dhoni).
- Travel, diving and cancellation insurance.

Not Included

- Flights to Male.
- Local taxes and government fees, payable on board.
- Optional soft drinks and alcohol.
- Rental equipment (available on request, must be booked before departure).
- Nitrox, priced per person per week.
- Day hotel option (direct payment if used).
- Internet connection.

Important

It is recommended to have Advanced Open Water certification or similar, with 50 logged dives.
