Huvadhoo Atoll - Fuvahmulah Atoll - Addu Atoll

100+ dives recommended and AOWD or equivalent + Nitrox qualified

Program

You'll set off on an extraordinary adventure with the Spirit of Maldives, diving into the southernmost realms of the Equatorial zone, where Huvadhoo, Fuvahmulah, and Addu Atolls await.

Your journey begins with a 60-minute return domestic flight to or from Kooddoo and Gan airports, connecting you to Male, just 300 miles north. As you cross the Equator, you'll join in the tradition of paying homage to Neptune, marking the transition with reverence.

Huvadhoo Atoll greets you with its deep, current-swept waters, where you'll experience spectacular, adrenaline-filled channel dives teeming with huge schools of pelagic fish, sharks, and rays.

You'll reef hook on the corner to watch the underwater spectacle, then drift with the currents, surrounded by a kaleidoscope of colorful reef fish. Inside the atoll, you'll explore tranquil shallow reefs with stunning coral formations and fascinating macro life, and at night, you might spot whale sharks at the back of the boat, drawn by the lights—a truly privileged sight.

South of Huvadhoo, you'll reach Fuvahmulah, where the ocean floor rises 2,000 meters to meet the atoll reef, creating a renowned dive site at a 100-foot (30-meter) deep plateau.


Here, you'll enjoy thrilling drift dives, keeping an eye out for hammerheads, threshers, silvertips, grey reefs, and the majestic tiger shark, all frequent visitors to these waters.

Further south lies Addu Atoll, home to the historic island of Gan, once a British Navy bunkering port and airbase during the Maldives' time as a protectorate.

You'll dive into the depths to explore the wreckage of the British Loyalty, now a thriving reef, and experience exhilarating drift dives in the eastern channels, while a mesmerizing manta cleaning station to the north lets you watch giant mantas glide gracefully as tiny cleaner wrasse tend to them.

This itinerary requires a 60-minute return domestic flight to/from Kooddoo and Gan airports
