INTRODUCTION

MAUMERE

Maumere is located in the middle east part of the island of Flores. Komodo and Labuhan Bajo are on the west side of the island. This puts Maumere almost straight above the island of Timor in the center of the spread-out Indonesia.

Maumere is beautiful with plenty of colorful reefs with calm waters that often attract whales and dolphins. Maumere is known for its muck dives and wall/dropp-off dives and is a great spot for those looking for less common places to scuba dive in Indonesia.

Besides scuba diving, Maumere is a perfect place for those looking for a traditional local experiences and natural attractions.

FORGOTTEN ISLANDS

The Forgotten islands are part of the Maluku Tenggara which is a 1,000 km chain of archipelagos running from East Timor to Western Papua. Undeveloped, distant from population centers and far off any beaten path, these "Forgotten Islands" have been largely isolated from the rest of the world. If you don't like to run into any other liveaboard cruise you could imagine yourself as the only person in the world on one of old trade ships. Then this is the route for you.

Forgotten Islands are for those who like diving some unexplored reefs and to spot schools of hammerhead sharks.

Arriving 1 day prior to cruise
departure is recommended. In the
case your flight is delayed or your
luggage is missing, this will allow
you time to make other
arrangements and not risk missing
your trip.

Travel light
A few light clothes and shorts
would do you good. You will be on
the sea and beaches with a lot of
sun. Do not forget to bring your
sun glasses, eco friendly sun
blocks, flip flops and of course a
camera to capture moments.

Visa For Non-Indonesian Citizen
Indonesia gives a 30 day Visa On
Arrival (VOA). Please check with
the representative of Indonesian
Embassy in your country if you are
eligible for this. Make sure your
passport is still valid for at least 6
months before entering Indonesia.
